CruiseCraft Explorer 625HT



CruiseCraft has added the Explorer 625HT (hardtop) to its range of hard-core fishing boats and says serious bluewater fishermen will be well-protected under the 625HT's hardtop cover when they head offshore under stormy skies or blistering summer sunshine.

CruiseCraft says the hardtop is an enhancement to its popular Explorer 625 and comes at a small additional cost over the 625's stainless steel folding targa/bimini setup.

The 625HT's hardtop is made from a tailor-made, two-piece, moulded system with a smooth gelcoat interior liner that makes it easy to clean and maintain. The two components are bonded together to form the hardtop shell. Supporting the aft-end of the structure is a pair of robust stainless steel supports, which double as secure grab-handles for the crew.

The hardtop has a full-height toughened-glass windscreen at the front, with sliding glass side panels to port and starboard and an electric windscreen wiper on the starboard screen. Under the hardtop cover, there's plenty of room for the crew (two seated at the helm, the others standing). An

optional slide-out canopy can be installed if additional shade is required.

With a LOA 6.54m (21.5ft) and 2.45m (8ft) beam, the 625HT has a 200hp rating and can carry 232lt of fuel. CruiseCraft says

the 625HT's generous cockpit size is a key feature, with ample space for three fishermen to stand across the width of the boat.
